

## Matters relating to Implementation of Provisional Anti-dumping Measures

General Administration of Customs Public Announcement No. (2006) 66

9 November 2006

Pursuant to the provisions of the *Anti-dumping Regulations of the People's Republic of China*, the Ministry of Commerce issued the Public Announcement No. (2006) 45 in respect of the decision to implement provisional anti-dumping measures for imported abrasion resistant paper originating from the United States and the European Union; and the General Administration of Customs issued the public announcement No. (2006) 34 on issues relating to the specific implementation thereof. In the course of investigation of the case, the Ministry of Commerce investigated as requested by the relevant interested parties, and upon confirmation by the Customs Tariff Commission of the State Council and the General Administration of Customs, the products under investigation should fall under tariff code 48043900 in the *Import and Export Tariffs of the People's Republic of China* (same hereinafter) instead of tariff code 48064000. As such, the Ministry of Commerce issued the Public Announcement No. (2006) 89 (see Appendix for details). Public announcement in respect of issues relating to implementation of provisional anti-dumping measures is hereby given as follows:

1. Products which fit the product description of abrasion resistant paper stated in the Ministry of Commerce Public Announcement No. (2006) 89 (see Appendix for details) shall fall under tariff code 48043900. With effect from 10 November 2006, anti-dumping security deposit shall be imposed on abrasion resistant paper originating from the United States and the European Union (tariff code: 48043900) according to different suppliers classified pursuant to the anti-dumping security deposit ratio stipulated in the General Administration of Customs Public Announcement No. (2006) 34.
2. Importers shall indicate commodity reference number as 4804390001 when completing declaration for imports of "raw abrasion resistant paper in roll or in sheets coated with abrasion resistant material aluminium oxide" under import tariff code 48043900; and indicate commodity reference number as 4804390009 when completing declaration for imports of "other kraft paper and cardboard not exceeding 150 gram per square metre in weight" under the import tariff code.

3. With effect from 10 November 2006, the Customs will not impose anti-dumping security deposit on products under tariff code 48064000 pursuant to the General Administration of Customs Public Announcement No. (2006) 34. Importers shall indicate commodity reference number as 4806400000 when completing declaration for import of products under tariff code 48064000. The Customs will not impose anti-dumping security deposit retrospectively on imports of abrasion resistant paper originating from the United States and the European Union for which importers have completed import declaration under tariff code 48043900 prior to 10 November 2006. Importers who have paid anti-dumping security deposit for import of products under tariff code 48064000 prior to 10 November 2006 may, within six months from 10 November 2006, apply for refund of the paid anti-dumping security deposit is paid from the Customs.

4. Other matters relating to the imposition of anti-dumping security deposit on imported resistant paper originating from the United States and European Union shall be executed pursuant to the relevant provisions of the General Administration of Customs Public Announcement No. (2006) 34.
